Renting at Old School Village:

The facility is available to members of the church.

- 1. If you are sixty years or older when entering an apartment, by paying a one-time entrance fee you are guaranteed that apartment for as long as you want--and are able--to live there (OSV must take your own safety and the safety of other residents into account). To be eligible for this sixty-and-above arrangement, you first need to be on OSV's waiting (priority) list, which costs \$500. This fee is refundable (if you want to get off the list); does not obligate you if an apartment becomes available and is offered to you, but you reject it; and goes toward the entrance fee if you accept the apartment.
- 2. Adults of any age may rent an apartment without first being on the waiting list or paying the entrance fee, but this is a month-to-month arrangement only. Renters in this category understand they may be asked to vacate if someone sixty-and-above who has priority (because they are on the waiting list) becomes ready to move in.
- 3. To get on the waiting list or ask about availability if thinking about living at OSV, call Tom Kerr (484-436-1014).
